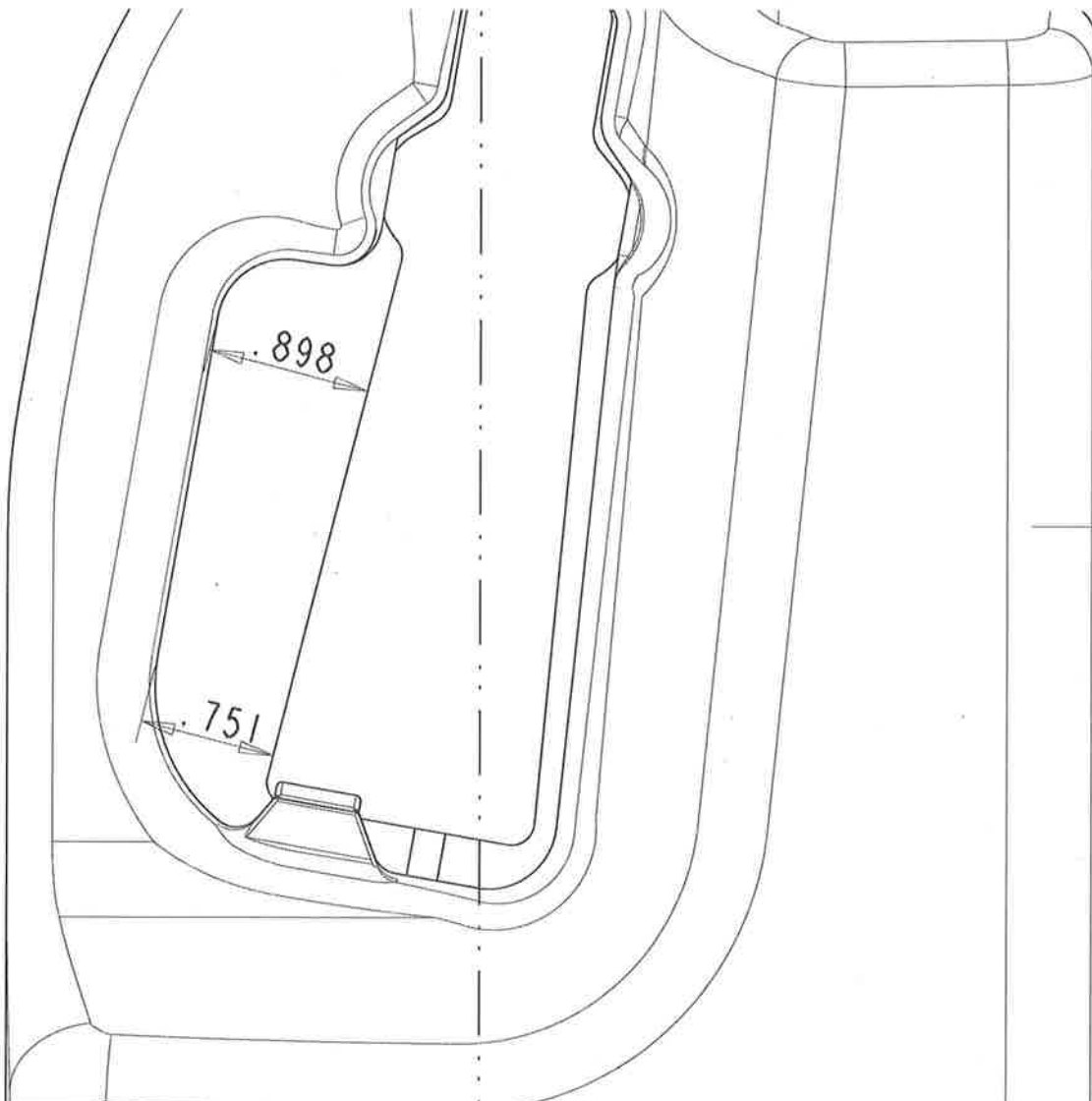

How to Use: Apply the solution to all exposed surfaces of the plant. Use a sufficient spray volume to obtain complete coverage of all foliage and stems. Uniform and complete coverage is essential for the most effective results. Do not apply to runoff.

When to Use: Start application before or at the first sign of disease. For best protection, repeat at one to two week intervals until conditions are no longer favorable for disease development. Shorten the interval during rainy weather or during periods of high relative humidity.

Where to Use:

Ornamental Trees, Flowers and Shrubs

Controls: Alternaria blight, Anthracnose, Black Spot, Botrytis gray mold, Cercospora leaf spot, Phomopsis blight, Powdery mildew, Scab, Septoria leaf spot.

Fruits and Vegetables

Controls: Alternaria leaf spot, Anthracnose, Botrytis, Downy mildew, Monilinia fruit & blossom rot, Powdery mildew.
