DIRECTIONS

MUST SHAKE ROOT CLEANER REALLY WELL. Before measuring, shake again during application. Pour 1 cup of mixed Root Cleaner solution per 1 gallon container at the base of each plant. Add water to help soak the solution into the media until it thoroughly irrigates through the bottom of the container. After 15-20 minutes rinse thoroughly with water. You must let your media dry for a day, and than reinoculate with nutrients and beneficials.
