Water grass thoroughly after application. For Billbug control, apply when activity is first observed or when chewed or brown grass indicates damage from these insects. For Grub control, except Dung Beetle, treat any time between late July and early October. For Dung Beetle Grub control, apply in spring or early summer when damage is first noticed. Water grass thoroughly with ¼ to ½ inch of water after application. Treat again in late summer or early fall if a second generation occurs.
