FIRST AID

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on Skin: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Personal Protection Equipment: Applicators and other handlers must wear long-sleeved shirt and pants, shoes plus socks, rubber gloves, and protective eyewear.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

GENERAL INFORMATION: SPRAY MASTER is intended for use with certain herbicides as recommended on the herbicide labels. Information on the herbicide labels takes precedence over this label. Observe all precautions and geographical restrictions on labels of herbicides and other additives.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: GENERAL: Use recommended rates of herbicide and additives. Slowly add SPRAY MASTER to tank when water level is at $\frac{3}{4}$ of the desired amount and agitation has been turned on, but before herbicide is added. SPRAY MASTER solutions may be corrosive to metal parts of sprayer or other equipment. Thoroughly flush the tank, pump, boom, nozzles and entire spray system with water.

GENERAL USE RATES FOR GLYPHOSATE HERBICIDES:

Use 8 to 17 pounds of SPRAY MASTER per 100 gallons of water.

OTHER HERBICIDES: Follow herbicide label directions.

STORAGE: Store in safe manner. Store in original container only. Store in cool, dry place. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Reduce stacking height where local conditions, such as humidity or pallet overhang, can affect package strength.

DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Do not reuse container. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal. The Agricultural Container Recycling Council (ACRC) operates the national recycling program. To contact your state and local ACRC recycler visit www.acrecycle.org. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/national regulations. Do not incinerate.
