2. What It Does

3. Where To Use

5. Application Directions

The maximum number of applications is 1 broadcast and 1 spot treatment per year OR 2 spot treatments per year OR 1 brush control application per year. The maximum annual rate is 2 gallons per 1,200 sq.ft. per year.

Equipment Cleanup: Thoroughly flush application equipment with water after using this product. Do not flush equipment near desirable plants or their root zones.

5.1 For Total Vegetation Control (Including **Bareground Treatment)**

Use hand-operated spray equipment such as backpack sprayers, pump-up sprayers, or sprinkling can. Dilute product with water before applying. For maximum effectiveness, apply when weeds are vigorously growing.

For Broadcast Treatments: Uniformly spray or sprinkle the area where no vegetation is desired. Mix 1 gallon of product with 3 gallons of water to cover 1.200 sq.ft.

For Fence Lines: Uniformly spray or sprinkle the strip where no vegetation is desired. Mix 1 gallon of product with 3 gallons of water to cover 1,200 sg.ft. (equal to 2.400 linear feet of fence line with a 6-inch band width).

For Spot Treatments: Spray or sprinkle the spots where no vegetation is desired. Mix 1 gallon of product with 3 gallons of water to cover 1,200 sq.ft. One spot treatment may be used after a broadcast treatment if weeds persist.

5.2 For Brush Control

Use hand-operated spray equipment such as backpack sprayers or pump-up sprayers. Apply product undiluted. Uniformly spray the foliage of woody weeds. Do not wet foliage excessively. Weeds should be growing vigorously at the time of application for maximum herbicide activity.
