## Sprayer Use Directions

Unscrew the tank cap and fill the tank with water up to the one gallon indicator. Remove the sprayer wand from the tank holster and unfold the sprayer wand. ## Change Cartridge Use Directions

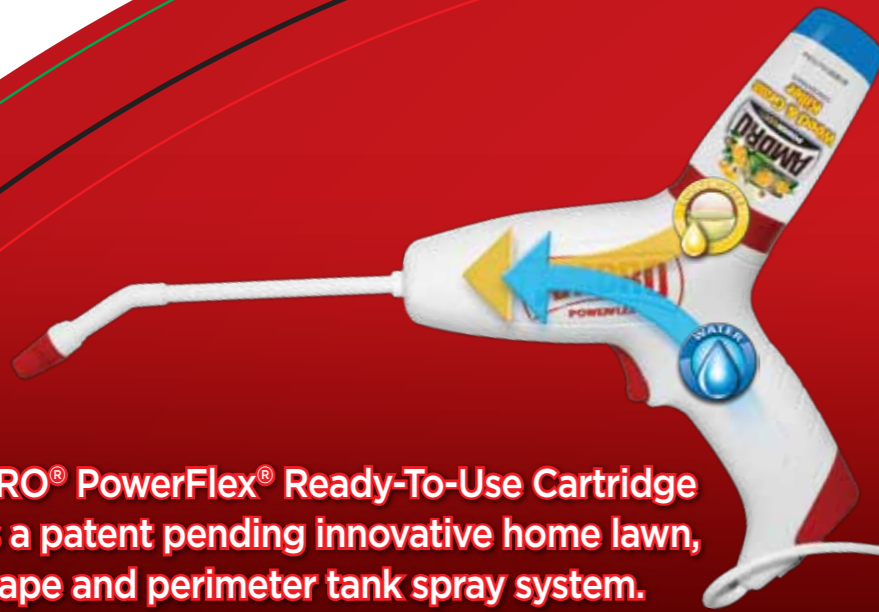

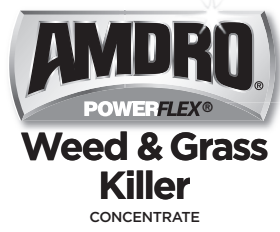

<b>Additional Tips</b>	To Kill Vines <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If vines are growing up poles, fences, or tree trunks with mature bark, cut vines to a height of 3 to 4 feet and spray vines thoroughly.</li> <li>• If vines are climbing shrubs, or tree trunks with green bark, cut vines at base and treat as directed for stumps or spray regrowth. If spraying regrowth, shield shrubs and green bark from spray drift with a sheet of cardboard or plastic.</li> </ul> Kudzu <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For best results, apply in mid to late summer when vines are mature and actively growing.</li> </ul> Wild Blackberry <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Spray anytime plants are actively growing. Dead canes should be cut down and removed.
