## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### UNCLE IAN'S DOG AND CAT REPELLENT

For outdoor use only. Before treatment, pick up all feces in area. Sprinkle Uncle Ian's generously onto all soiled areas or any area you don't want dogs or cats to go. Repeat treatment on soiled areas for five consecutive days. If rain occurs, reapply. Safe to use around lawns, flower beds or vegetable gardens. To use as a repellent station for dogs, pour two cups of Uncle Ian's into a nylon or sock, tie a knot in the open end and hang from a garbage can, tree or shrub.

**Uncle Ian's repels by taste and smell naturally. It is safe to use around children, pets, wildlife and will not harm your plants of your lawn.**

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

**Storage:** Store in the original package in a cool dry place and out of reach of children and pets.

**Disposal:** Empty container may be disposed of in regular trash. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

## INSTRUCCIONES DE USO

### EL REPELENTE DEL TIO IAN DE GATOS Y PERROS

Para uso en el zonas exteriores unicamente. Antes del tratamiento, recoger todas las heces en la zona. Espolvoree tío Ian generosamente sobre todas las áreas sucias o cualquier área donde no quiere que vayan perros o gatos. Repita el tratamiento en áreas sucias durante cinco días consecutivos. Si llueve, volver a aplicar. Se puede utilizar sin riesgo alrededor de céspedes, lechos de flores o jardines de vegetales. Para utilizar como una estación de repelente para perros, vierta dos tazas de tío Ian en unas medias o un calcetín, haga un nudo en el extremo abierto y cuelgue de un bote de basura, árbol o arbusto.

**Tío Ian's repele naturalmente por el sabor y el olor. Es seguro utilizar alrededor de niños, mascotas, vida silvestre y no dañará a sus plantas o su césped.**

#### ALMACENAMIENTO Y ELIMINACIÓN

No contamine el agua, alimentos por almacenamiento y eliminación.

**Almacenamiento:** Almacenar en su envase original en un lugar fresco y seco y fuera del alcance de los niños y mascotas.

**Eliminación:** Recipiente vacío puede eliminarse en la basura regular. Si está parcialmente lleno: llame a su agencia local de desecho sólidos para obtener instrucciones. ¡Nunca coloque el producto sin usar en ningún drenaje interior o exterior.

Do not induce vomiting unless doctor instructs. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
