



Deer & Rabbit Repellent

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Gently Sprinkle the Heavy Weight Deer & Rabbit Repellent powder directly on your Flowers, Ornamental Plants, Landscaped Garden Areas or Trees while they are moist from light rain or heavy dew. If plants are dry, give them a light misting from a suitable water sprayer before applying powder. To apply the powder turn the canister upside down and shake the powder onto the parts of the plant to be protected from browsing. Do not apply too much powder as the excess will fall to the ground and be wasted. Take care that the powder in the applicator does not become wet and clog the openings. To protect against browsing of new growth, apply powder at the onset of browsing, but preferably after bud break and before new shoots exceed 1 inch in length. Do not re-treat new growth.

Roses: Slight discoloration of petals or leaves may result from the use of this product.

Conifer Trees: For large trees, apply only to lateral branches within animal's reach. Repeat as

Note: Do not apply this product to any plant grown for use as human food or animal feed. This product will typically will not wash off after a rain, however it may be beneficial to re-apply after a heavy downpour.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Wash thoroughly with

FIRST AID:

If Swallowed:

- · Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
- · Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.

- · Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled:

- · Move person to fresh air.
- Drink water to clear throat and blow nose to evacuate dust.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.
- · Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store the product in the original container, in a dry, cool (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets. Store above freezing. Store with the container tightly closed to prevent spillage or evaporation of the product.

If **Spilled:** Vacuum clean dust with equipment fitted with HEPA filter. Use a dust suppressant such as water if sweeping is necessary. Use adequate ventilation to minimize dust exposure.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

If empty: Do not reuse this container; place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
