# **HOW TO USE**

# TO KILL BED BUGS AND BED BUG EGGS

Spray bugs and eggs directly wherever possible. Remove linens and wash before reuse. On infested mattresses, apply as spot (no more than 2 sq ft) treatment only to tufts, seams, folds, and edges until moist; allow mattress to dry before remaking bed. Apply to bedsprings, box springs, and the interio of hed frames or headhoards, including all cracks and joints. Apply to cracks and crevices on all paseboards, moldings, beneath floor coverings and carpets, closets, shelves, curtains, furniture, pictur frames, and luggage that may harbor bed bugs. Keeps on killing bed bugs for up to 30 days

# TO KILL TICKS AND FLEAS

Apply as a spot (no more than 2 sq ft) treatment on and around pet sleeping quarters, bedding, an pet's habitat. Treat carpeting, furniture and floor coverings where fleas and ticks are found.

# TO KILL LISTED CRAWLING PESTS
