



Wasp & Hornet Killer 2 can be used both Indoors (Attics, anywhere nests are built, and where food or feed is not exposed) & Outdoors on Wasp, Hornet, and Yellow Jacket nests.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

USE RESTRICTIONS: • Do not use in commercial food/feed processing, preparation, food/feed storage or serving areas. • Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying and turn aquarium systems off. • Do not water the treated area to the point of runoff. • Do not make applications during the rain. • All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted uses:

1. Treatment to soil or vegetation around structures: • All outdoor applications to impervious surfaces such as sidewalks, driveways patios porches and structural surfaces (such as windows, doors, and eaves) are limited to spot and crack-and-crevice treatments only. • Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after applications. • Do not apply when food is present. • Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated areas until sprays have dried. • Do not apply directly to sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur, except as directed by the label. • Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adult, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.

OUTDOOR USES: Under eaves, near window frames, doorways, carports, picnic areas, and outdoor play areas. **INDOOR USES:** Attics, anywhere nests are built, and where food or feed is not exposed. Kills insects and eliminate the nests where they live and breed. Insects will fall to the ground and die after spraying; kills any insects inside the nest as well as any returning. In the home, cover all food/feed processing surfaces and utensils during treatment. Cover or remove exposed food/feed.

For Control of Wasps, Yellow Jackets, Hornets and other listed insects:

For Nests: 1. Spray at sunrise or sunset when insects are least active. 2. Stand a safe distance from the nest. Do not stand directly underneath. 3. Shake can well before each use. Hold can upright and spray away from person. Push button to spray. 4. Aim actuator at the opening in the nest and spray until soaked. 5. Then spray the rest of the nest until it is saturated. This product's powerful spray will also kill insects that return to the nest. 6. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To Kill Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets, Spiders (including Black Widow Spiders), Crickets, Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Scorpions, Centipedes, Earwigs, Flies, and Mosquitoes: 1. Spray 1-2 seconds until surface is moist to kill insects under eaves, around screens, windows, doors, patios, cracks, holes and crevices or wherever insects are noticed. 2. To prevent insects from entering the home, spray around areas where insects enter such as outdoor plumbing, faucets, etc. and cracks or crevices in foundations as well as along sills and ledges. Do not apply more than one time per day to same surface. **Use Tips:** 1. If windy, stand with the wind at your back to avoid spray drift. 2. Avoid spraying vegetation directly. 3. Foliage of desirable plants that were contacted with spray should be hosed off. This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame, preferably in a locked storage area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food and pet food.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Do not puncture or incinerate! Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment wash waters or rinsate. Drift and runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in water adjacent to treated areas. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FIRST AID:

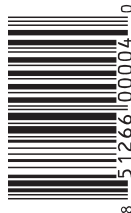
