This product is compatible with most chemicals used in pool water and will not damage tile, concrete, metal or plastics.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Swimming Pools and Outdoor Spas: Add this product directly to the pool water along edges while filter and pump are in operation. To provide time for even distribution in the pool water, bathers must wait a minimum of 15 minutes after the addition of this product before entering the pool.

For initial treatment of clean pools and spas, add 5-8 oz. of this product for every 10,000 gallons of water (2-3 ppm active quaternary). Maintenance additions of 2-3 oz. per 10,000 gallons (0.5-1 ppm active quaternary) should be added every 7 days, or more frequently depending on water and use factors. A booster dose of 2 oz. per 10,000 gallons (0.5 ppm active quaternary) should be provided after each rain.

For pools and spas with visible algae, add 14 oz. of this product for every 10,000 gallons of water (5 ppm active quaternary). After 24 hours, remove dead algae by cleaning. If algae is still present, repeat dosage as necessary.

For Winterization:

1. This product aids in the prevention of algae in swimming pools during the winter months, when the pool is out of service.
2. Test water for hardness, alkalinity, pH and the presence of metals. Take corrective action if necessary.
3. Superchlorinate the pool using an EPA registered winter shock treatment product. Follow the manufacturer's label directions.
4. Apply this product directly to the pool water, pouring along the edges of the pool. Use 14 oz. per 10,000 gallons of water (5 ppm active quaternary) and allow to circulate 2-4 hours. Pools without covers may need a second treatment in mid-winter or just prior to freezing.
5. Clean pool piping and filter. In geographical areas that experience freezing, drain pool equipment and plumbing lines, or use an anti-freeze recommended for swimming pool plumbing and equipment.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if inhaled, swallowed, or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe vapor. 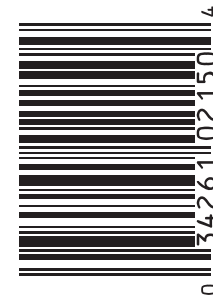
