

FOR PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE:

Dilute 1/2-1 OZ. per 1 GAL. of water. Apply using an atomizer, misting system, or other spraying apparatus. Thoroughly wet plants until foliage is dripping including the underside of the leaves and surface of growing medium. Apply preventative maintenance 1-2 times per week, preferably routinely on the same days/times. Apply at the end of a light cycle or just before dusk to prevent foliar damage.

* Test spray a few leaves prior to full application.

FOR INFESTATIONS: Dilute 2 OZ. per 1 GAL. of water for most applications. For severe infestations, it may be necessary to dilute up to 4 OZ. per 1 GAL. of water. Apply using an atomizer, misting system, or other spraying apparatus. Thoroughly wet plants until foliage is dripping, including the underside of leaves and surface of growing medium. Apply product every other day, up to 3 times per week at the end of light cycle, or just before dusk to prevent foliar damage.
