# DIRECTIONS

## SHAKE WELL WHILE USING.

Spray directly onto insects and infected areas until thoroughly covered. Periodically shake mixture.

Complete coverage of all plant is necessary for controlling mites. Make sure to spray under the leaves where spider mites hide and lay their eggs.

To reduce the chance of damage to leaves, do not use under direct sunlight or grow lamps.

May be used on food and feed crops.

Allow Instant Mite Killer 15 minutes to fully attack mites and eggs.
