## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.**

1. Shake well.
2. Adjust nozzle to coarse spray pattern to minimize wind drift.
3. Spray just enough product to lightly cover weeds. **Excessive spraying can injure some lawns.** Do not spray weeds growing within the dripline of trees. Do not apply when daytime temperatures are above 85°F as lawn injury can occur. Application when temperatures are below 60°F may result in slower appearance of weed control. Spray only the weeds, not the entire lawn.
4. Weeds will begin wilting and browning overnight.

## USE RESTRICTIONS

- Limited to two spot treatments per year (a spot application is defined as an area no greater than 1,000 sq ft per acre)
