One application of Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer provides 6 months control of broadleaf weeds\* and annual grasses in flower and ornamental beds. Plus it helps landscaped areas retain moisture - protecting your plants, trees and shrubs from extreme temperatures. Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer provides increased weed\* control when used as directed.

**WHEN TO APPLY**  
This mulch contains preemergent herbicides and for best results, remove all weeds in the beds prior to applying Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer. Apply in the spring and fall after renovating beds. For best results, apply Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer after flowers and ornamentals have been planted into the soil. Do not apply over flower seeds.

**HOW TO APPLY**  
**Bulbs and Perennials** — Spread Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer over the area to a depth of two inches. Do not plant flowers directly into mulch. If additional planting is desired after Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer has been applied, first remove the mulch from the selected area. Avoid getting treated mulch in the planting hole. Once the plant is firmly embedded in the soil, replace the mulch around the plant.  
**Annuals** — After plants have been set in the soil bed, spread Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer over the area to a depth of two inches. Make no more than one application per site per year. The active ingredients in Preen Mulch with Extended Control Weed Preventer can cause injury to some annuals. If you have a concern about damage to your annuals, do not use this product.

This product should be soil-incorporated within 24 hours of application either by at least 0.5 acre inch of water (rainfall, irrigation) or mechanical incorporation. If a second incorporation is needed it should be delayed 3 to 5 days after the first incorporation and be completed prior to planting.
