**FIRST AID**

**IF IN EYES:**

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes.

**CAUTION:** Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface water. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Rinsing application equipment over the treated area will help avoid run off to water bodies or drainage system.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated areas until after the spray has dried.

**PRODUCT INFORMATION**

**HOW IT WORKS**

This product enters the plants through the foliage and moves down to the roots systemically, thereby killing it. Weeds die, roots and all, so they don't grow back. Kills only what you spray. Any product not absorbed by the plant will be rendered inactive after it hits the soil. This product has no soil residual activity. Sprayed weeds wilt within 3 hours with complete kill in 1 to 2 weeks.

**WHERE TO USE**

- Along fences and foundations
- Around shrubs and trees
- Edging (around foundations and retaining walls)
- Flower beds and Vegetable gardens
- On patios, walkways and driveways, gravel or mulch beds
- Driveways and patios
- On wooded or vacant lots
- Other areas of your yard
- Other areas where weeds are invading your yard

**HOW TO APPLY**

- Adjust nozzle to the desired spray setting.
  - Spray the weeds or grasses you want to kill until thoroughly wet.
  - When spot treating weeds around desirable plants, shield plants from drift with a sheet of cardboard or plastic.
- If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse off immediately with water or cut off treated area.

**IMPORTANT**

- Do not spray plants or grasses you like - they will die. NOT for spot weed control use in lawns since this product kills lawn grasses.

**WHEN TO APPLY**

- Apply when weeds are actively growing.
- For best results, apply during warm, sunny weather above 60° F to accelerate systemic movement from foliage to roots.
- Spray when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants.
- RAINPROOF PROTECTION: Rain or watering 10 minutes after application will NOT wash away effectiveness.
- Apply when weeds are small and before seeds form.
- Established hard to kill weeds may require a repeat application.

**WHEN TO REPLANT**

- All ornamental flowers, trees and shrubs may be planted 1 day after application.
- Lawn grasses, herbs, vegetables and fruits may be planted 3 days after application.

**ADDITIONAL TIPS**

**POISON IVY AND POISON OAK**

Contact with these plants anytime of the year can cause an allergic reaction. Spray anytime plants are actively growing, but at least 4 weeks before the first killing frost in the fall. Reapply, if new growth appears. Handle dead plants with rubber gloves. Dispose of plants and rubber gloves in tightly sealed garbage bags.

**FOR FLOWERBED AND GARDEN PREPARATION**

- Use this product to kill weeds, grasses and brush before planting flowers, fruits, vegetables, trees or shrubs.
- If soil is dry, water before application and 2 to 3 days after application.
- Apply evenly over treatment area.
- Wait 1 to 3 days after last application before planting garden, flowers, trees and shrubs. See "When To Replant" section for details.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.  
**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Rotate nozzle to closed position. Store product in original container in a safe place away from direct sunlight. Keep from freezing.  
**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If Empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If Partly Filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
