DIRECTION FOR USE: Orange Guard Adjuvant Spray General Purpose Spreader / Sticker can be used with citric acid or hydrogen peroxide active insecticide to improve the performance of the active spray ingredient by giving it more uniform distribution and better wetting of the plant surface. Always read and follow the label of the pesticide(s) and additive(s) to be used with this product. Always refer the pesticide and additive label(s) for additional directions or precautions. Follow the most restrictive label. Variations and conditions of use can cause some variation in the amount of this product required. The minimum to give a smooth uniform coverage usually gives the most effective results. Dilute active ingredients (Citric Acid or Hydrogen Peroxide) per their label directions. Mix 8 parts to 50 parts finished active dilution with 1 part Orange Guard Adjuvant Spray. Read and follow the directions for use on the active ingredients label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a dry place. Store in closed container.
